BORALEX ACQUIRES N.Y. SOLAR PROJECT

Canadian renewables developer Boralex has acquired the 20 MW (ac) Sky High solar farm in Tully, N.Y., from Delaware River Solar, LLC, according to a <u>press release</u>.

Construction of the Sky High project is expected to be completed by 3Q22. It is ground-mounted and being developed on three separate parcels of land across 145 acres, with a forecasted output estimated at 35 GWh annually.

Delaware River Solar put the project up for sale last fall via Rhynland, a power and infrastructure advisory firm, as previously <u>reported</u> by *SparkSpread*.

Boralex will have the option to sell electricity from the project, which is located in Zone A of the New York ISO, via a power purchase agreement or a hedge. The project currently has a 25-year Renewable Energy Credit contract with New York State Energy Research & Development (NYSERDA).

In 2018, Sky High was one of 26 projects to be selected by NYSERDA as part of its 2017 Renewable Energy Standard Solicitation for the purchase of Tier-1 Eligible Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs). Each REC represents the environmental attributes of one MWh of electricity generated from an eligible renewable source.
